

Since 1990 Montgomery County has made a commitment to assisting our county's farming communities by creating opportunities for preserving and maintaining working farms as a valued economic, cultural and natural resource.

The Montgomery County Farmland Preservation Program makes it possible for eligible farmers to hold on to their land and to continue their farming operation by selling an agricultural easement. When the easement is sold, the owner keeps the land but no longer has the right to build non-agricultural buildings. The land must remain in farming in perpetuity. If the farmer later sells the land, the new owner must continue to grow productive crops or pastures. Applying to the program is voluntary.

As of October 2011, 140 farms have been approved for permanent preservation, for a total of 8,379 acres of county farmland that will never be developed. Those farmers who are interested in preserving their land are encouraged to submit an application to Elizabeth Emlen.

The Montgomery County Commissioners adopted the Open Space Program in 2003 following a voter referendum. The 10-year \$150 million Green Fields/Green Towns initiative covers municipal and private organization grants, and county open space expenditures.

Funds support farmland preservation, land acquisition, heritage resource conservation, green infrastructure, floodplain restoration, community trails, and implementation of the Schuylkill River Greenway.

The county has used open space funds to develop an open space network. Projects include development and preservation of trails and greenways; capital improvements, planning, land acquisition and easements that expand, protect and enhance county parks, historic sites and natural areas; continuation and expansion of the farmland preservation program; and implementation of the Schuylkill River Greenway.
