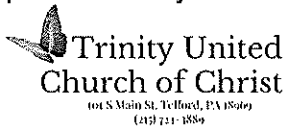


**REPORT TO MUNICIPALITIES

May, 2017**



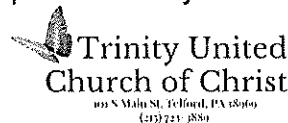

Soon you will be able to reserve Museum Passes online up to 90 days in advance using a library card in good standing. Because of the popularity we are also adding new museums to our pass program. We will also begin a new service at IVPL- **Mobile Hotspots**. The Library Hotspot program allows library card holders to access high-speed Internet service anywhere a Sprint signal can be received. Connect up to five devices at a time, including desktops, laptops, tablets, smartphones, etc. Perfect for those who have no Internet access at home, are going on vacation, or taking their business on the road. You will also be able to reserve the Hotspots online up to 90 days in advance for a length of 7 days.
