NEW BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION 15-1715 – THUC THI NGUYEN LAND DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL – Solicitor lannozzi explained the proposal for expansion of Ridge Road Temple which has been reviewed and recommended by both Township and County Planning Commissions; one of the conditions for approval includes agreement from the Temple that a deed restriction be placed on the property and no further religious use expansion would occur at the property. Temple to prepare deed restriction document for Solicitor review and recording. Rolph Graf (Temple Engineer) also summarized the land development process reviewed by all over the past year. Jim Styer inquired about surrounding resident meetings that may have taken place. Tom Neff inquiried if any comments were received from neighbors on the 1998 special exception – Rolph Graf advised there were none. Motion 15-010 by Styer, second by Neff approved Resolution 15-1715 granting conditional preliminary/final approval of land development application for a 2,930 square foot expansion of Linh Quang Buddhist Temple. Motion carried 3 – 0.

RESOLUTION 15-1716 - MASON / DIEHL LOT LINE APPROVAL - Solicitor Iannozzi explained proposal for minor lot line adjustments involving 75 and 85 Salford Way. This lot line adjustment has also been reviewed and recommended by both Township and County Planning Commissions for approval. Subject to recording Township Engineer should review to ensure accuracy of boundary lines. <u>Motion 15-011</u> by Styer, second by Lynch approved

Resolution 15-1716 granting conditional preliminary/final approval of the Patrick Diehl and Tammy Mason minor lot line adjustment application. Motion carried 3-0.

POST OFFICE LEASE – Jim Styer explained the letter of intent received from Post Office representative for consideration of lease renewal. Discussion was held on options to renew and/or not renew the post office lease. Unanimous opinion of all supervisors is to recommend renew the new lease on a year-to-year basis. Jim Styer will respond to CBRE proposal for 5 year term and advise of township recommendation to extend the lease on a year to year basis with no lease commission.
