PUBLIC HEARING - PROPOSED ORDINANCE #173 - Solicitor Stephen Imms opened the hearing to consider adoption of Ordinance #173 revising zoning ordinance to comply with changes to the National Flood Insurance Program Rules and Regulations. The proposed ordinance was advertised and reported exhibits for the record. Solicitor called for questions from the BOS and/or public. - C. QUARTERLY SEWER RATE: draft analysis of splitting pump maintenance costs between both sewer districts was discussed. Barb Lynch recommended the long term solution is future discussion with Franconia Sewer Authority.
