APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 18TH MINUTES - Motion 17-146 by Baker, second by Styer – motion carried 3 – 0.

APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE INVOICES & INTER-FUND TRANSFERS - Motion 17-148 by Styer, second by Lynch – motion carried 3 – 0.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A. FIRE ARM DISCHARGE** - Solicitor Steve Imms explained the legal standpoint of PA state regulations on municipalities governing fire arm discharge. Discussion held on enforcement and regulating in VCR district versus township wide. **Motion 17-147** by Lynch, second by Baker authorizing Solicitor to draft a Fire Arm Discharge Ordinance for review/consideration at November 15th meeting. Motion carried 3 – 0.

- B. REVIEW PRELIMINARY 2018 BUDGET(S)** - Barb Lynch requested BOS meet in Executive Session on November 15th to discuss areas of concern such as extreme increases/decreases in budget. Road projects and increases were discussed.
