APPROVAL OF COMMITTEE AND STAFF REPORTS - Motion 16-138 by Styer, second by Yothers - motion carried 3 - 0.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

A. PMRS RETIREMENT PLAN - Following review and confirmation that PMRS plan does not affect Fire Relief Allocation, Jim Styer also presented a savings analysis. <u>Motion 16-139</u> by Styer, second by Yothers approved PMRS Retirement Plan for all full time employees effective 1/1/2017. Motion carried 3 - 0.

- **B.** SEWER DELINQUENCY PROCEDURE Proposed sewer delinquency policy/procedure was submitted from Solicitor and reviewed by BOS. Given progress made of past delinquencies, options were discussed to do nothing or adopt as policy for future. Motion 16-140 by Styer, second by Yothers approving sewer delinquency procedures with any potential shut offs being approved by BOS in advance. Motion carried 3 0.
- C. CODIFICATION REVIEW UPDATE Memorandum's received from Township Engineer, Road Superintendent and Township Secretary on codification review of Non-Land Use, Zoning, SD and LD recommendations. Copy of Gilmore recommendations regarding zoning, SD and LD to be forwarded to Planning Commission for review/discussion.

- B. MUSSELMAN PARCEL (S. DIETZ MILL ROAD) Discussion held on communication between Township Solicitor and Solicitor for this parcel for sale. Parcel #44-00-00568-00-9 has an accessory use structure without a dwelling. Township Solicitor will draft a letter to property owner advising of BOS consensus.
