### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- A. BOG TURTLE STUDY** – Discussion was held on previous studies and including them in the grant application. The BOS unanimously agreed not to proceed with another bog turtle study.
- B. YELLOW BARN FARM RESTORATION SITE** – Curt Klingerman reported on the mitigation which will be included in the next phase of turnpike construction.
- C. AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN** – Karen reported the application has been fully submitted on the DCED website. Future use of funds TBD – No monies received to date.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. RESOLUTION 21-1860** – Motion 21-094 by Lynch, second by Myers approved extending Whites Mill Winter Maintenance Agreement. Motion passed 3 – 0.

- B. YOGA CLASS AT PARK** – Karen reported a resident requested to hold yoga class at Park on Sunday of evenings with donations received to benefit Tylersport Fire Company. The BOS had no objections.
- C. SENATE BILL #554** – Solicitor reported on SB554 which amends the Sunshine Act requiring agendas for all public meetings be posted on website 24 hours prior to meeting.
- D. SMALL CELL FACILITIES** – Solicitor reported on legislation intended to effect the FCC regulations. Referred to joint BOS/PC meeting for further review and amendments to zoning ordinance.
- E. KING ROAD BRIDGE** – Barb Lynch reported on potential meeting scheduled August 13<sup>th</sup> with County regarding bridge repairs. Railing specifications and weight limit of emergency vehicles was discussed.
