ANNOUNCEMENT OF EXECUTIVE SESSION – Barb Lynch reported the BOS met at 7:00 PM in Executive Session.

APPROVAL OF AUGUST 21ST MINUTES – Motion 24-085 by Lynch, second by Yothers. Motion passed 3 – 0.

APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTS PAYABLE INVOICES & INTER-FUND TRANSFERS – Motion 24-086 by Lynch, second by Myers. Motion passed 3 – 0.

OLD BUSINESS:

DRY WELL UPDATE – Barb Lynch provided the following updates regarding well issues:

1. Public Meeting with DEP scheduled for Thursday, October 3, 2024.
2. Met with North Penn Water Authority (NPWA) to determine feasibility of extending public water. Motion 24-087 by Lynch, second by Yothers to authorize expenditures not to exceed \$5,000 to reimburse NPWA to conduct the initial steps to determine the possibility of the extension of the public water system to address the situation of dry wells in the Township. Motion passed 3 – 0.
3. Montgomery County Health Department is researching sources of private funding.

BACKSTOP REGULATION ORDINANCE – Solicitor provided copies of sample ordinances; Supervisors to review a draft proposed ordinance at the September 18th meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:
