B. KING ROAD BRIDGE TURNBACK AGREEMENT – Solicitor, Township Engineer, Chairman Barb Lynch and Curt Klingerman to participate in conference call with Montgomery County to agree on acceptable terms of conditions.

A. SLAVEK/BERND SUBDIVISION – Solicitor reported on Resolution 19-1825 granting preliminary/final approval and imposing conditions on approval. Barb McMonagle (Planning Commission) reported on waivers requested. Building permits, zoning permits and stormwater management procedures of land

B. TRAFFIC SIGNAL RECOMMENDATION – Doug Hedrick commented on Armour & Sons report of the deterioration of traffic light at Ridge and Allentown Road intersection. Mark Mattucci provided information on Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) grant program application due June 30th. Barb Lynch requested Gilmore to provide an estimate of cost of engineering services for grant application.

C. TYLERSPORT PARK MAINTENANCE REQUEST – Frank Jarrett reported on Park Board request to install a drain pipe from parking lot to rain garden to alleviate/reduce current runoff problems. Curt Klingerman commented on putting an inlet below the pavilion. Park Board and Curt to work on a joint solution.
